I developed an SQL script that automated most of this process. This ensured the cleanup of over seven million user records during my time with the company.
- I was also part of the development team that created an internal CMS for the company. One of the project's key features was generating draggable elements and saving their positions on the user's screen. For this, we leveraged JavaScript's drag-and-drop properties.
